#### Stay Awake at All Times!

Sister Brigid was telling me about her chaplaincy group at St Joseph's primary school. They were reflecting on today's Gospel and Sister Brigid had to stress how the call by Jesus to "stay awake" was not an excuse for midnight feasts or binge-watching *YouTube* videos. Any parents who discovered a sudden unwillingness of their youngster to go to sleep in the past week, now know to whom their complaints should be directed.

Rather Jesus is calling us in Advent to be vigilant, to be prepared, to be ready for him. The Jewish people were told by God through the teaching of the prophets that they needed to be prepared and alert for the coming of the Messiah, yet very few were. We too are called to be prepared for the return of Jesus, his second coming, in glory. But how often do we think about it? Advent is a time to be more aware of this promise by Jesus and to live our faith with more commitment, passion and resolve. To be vigilant, watchful, and spiritually awake.

So, Advent isn't about passively waiting, with little more effort than opening the windows of our Advent calendar; it's about actively engaging with the world around us. We're called to reflect on our actions, choices, and the state of our souls. In staying awake, there's an encouragement to be alert to the needs of others, to recognize opportunities to serve, and to be present for those who require support and compassion.

Our parishes are blessed with people who are eager and willing to volunteer and be of service to their local community. But in Advent perhaps reflect whether you could give some of your time to help support and strengthen our parish communities. Perhaps that's in a regular way, such as helping at our coffee mornings, helping in outreach programmes or hidden tasks like cleaning or perhaps it is being generous at parish events whether by bringing food or helping others. Perhaps, if you're young, it's about praying about whether God is calling you to serve at the altar or be in the youth choir at 12:00 noon Mass or the 11:00am choir.

Such generosity embodies vigilance in action. It necessitates an awake, attentive heart sensitive to the Church's needs, the body of Christ's needs, as St Paul says. When we volunteer, we embody the essence of Christ's teachings—selflessness, compassion, and service to others.

It is not only us who benefit from the generosity of our time and effort, we prepare the way for Christ in the hearts of those we serve. It's a tangible expression of the Advent spirit—preparing the path for love, hope, and kindness to enter the lives of those who are marginalized, lonely, or in need. It was that spirit the shepherds and kings had when they recognised the call to come and pay homage to the infant king.
