The Nativity of Jesus is one of the most painted scenes of all time. The richness and variety is incredible. One reason for the variety is that, so often, like the artwork by Piero della Francesca above, the artist captures the scene with figures in contemporary dress and playing instruments of the time. We shouldn't flinch from this inaccuracy, because it reveals a deeper truth: the Nativity of Jesus transcends the confines of time and space. It is a momentous event that is equally relevant to every generation, as it was to the shepherds and wise men who came to the crib. God became one with us, the timeless Word became flesh. He entered our world. It begins a new era of hope and salvation for humanity. The crib in Bethlehem is not merely a historical incident but an ongoing revelation of God's boundless love.

The message of the Nativity reminds us that God's love knows no bounds and His presence is constant. Whilst we might not see the infant Christ in the simplicity of a stable, we are in his presence before our tabernacle today and on the altar at Mass. In these Christ is present to us in our
