Around the World in Eight Days

On Wednesday I went to the opening of the Child of War exhibition at the Ukrainian Cathedral. It shows, in moving ways, the plight of children affected by conflict in Ukraine as well as in other parts of the world.

One guest asked Fr Mykola and me to which Christian denomination we belonged. "Catholic", said I. "Yes", chimed in the Cathedral's administrator, "Canon Kevin is the right lung and I am the left".

It is hard to believe that over two years have passed since I wrote here about how we could show solidarity with our Ukrainian brothers and sisters by attending liturgies in Duke Street. Moreover, I explained how the Ukrainian Catholic Church and the Western (Latin) Church are in full communion such that members of either rite can receive the Body of Christ at one another's liturgies.

Next Sunday sees the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*, the Body and Blood of Christ, when we mark that extraordinary gift of the Real Presence of Our Saviour in the Eucharist. As St John Vianney puts it, "The priest utters a few words and the Lord descends from heaven at his voice, to be contained within a small host."

In *Corpus Christi* church in Covent Garden lies the Diocesan Shrine of the Blessed Sacrament. Leading up to their parish feast they are having an Octave of the Eucharist Full details are here <https://catholicengland.org/programme/> and in the porch.

Commencing from Saturday 25 May, different forms of the Mass within our beautiful universal Church will be celebrated – on Monday the Dominican Rite, Tuesday the Maronite (Lebanese) Rite, Wednesday the Ukrainian Rite, Friday the Ordinariate Use of the Roman Rite, while the other days will be the Roman Rite in English and Latin. In addition there are preachers from each rite including Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendía (Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain) and Bishop Kenneth Nowakowski, Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy. And it will all end with a Blessed Sacrament Procession through Central London on Sunday.

So let us, with both lungs fully expanded, show great love for our Eucharistic Lord by attending these Masses and bringing to the Prince of Peace our prayers for all His children of war, wherever they may be. *Canon Kevin*
