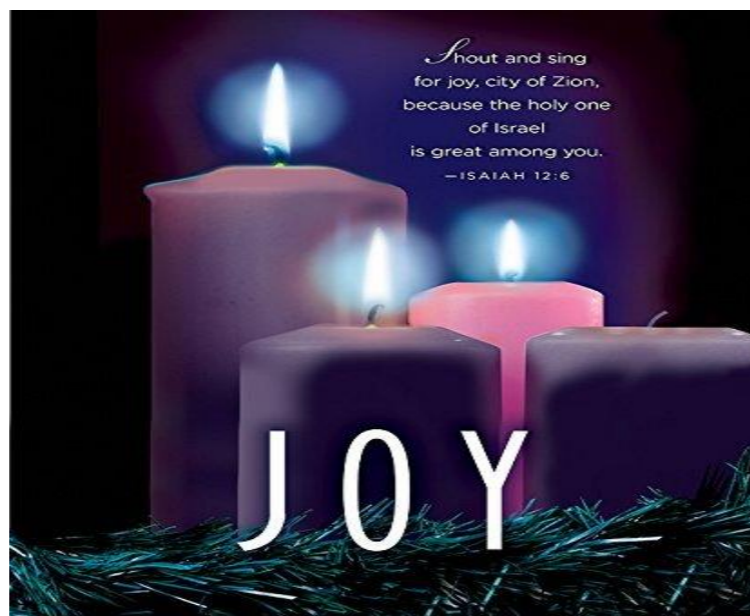

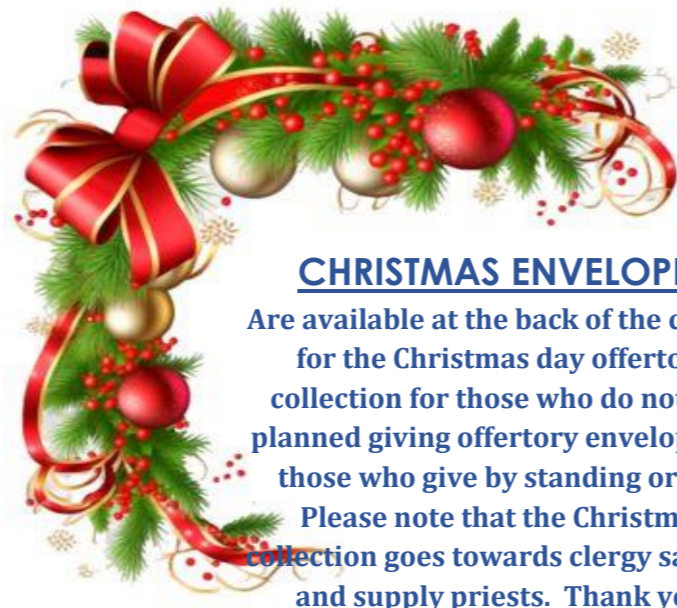

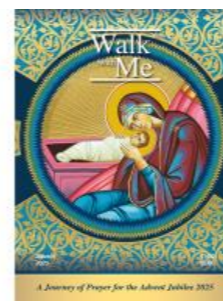
Sessions will start again in the new year. Next session Sunday 11th January 2026 at 10.00am.
