

## Sunday 29th September 2019 TWENTY SIXTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

Welcome to all at Mass today, especially to any visitors and particularly those who are here for the first time. Please take this sheet home with you which will tell you about this week's celebration and the activities during the week and also to remind you of our Liturgy today.

### TODAY'S MASS



A major theme in the Gospel of Luke is the importance of the care of the poor in the life of discipleship. In the parable found in today's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the life of a rich man and the poor man, Lazarus, who lives in the shadow of the rich man and his wealth. Both die. Lazarus finds himself in heaven; the rich man in the netherworld. The rich man asks for assistance from Lazarus in his

torment. But Abraham reminds the rich man of the good things he had in his life and describes the current situation as a reversal of fortunes. The rich man then asks that Lazarus be sent to warn his family, but this is denied with the reminder that Moses and the prophets have warned of judgment for those who neglect the care of the poor.

**First Reading: Amos 6:1,4-7**

God will judge the complacency of the people and their leaders.

**Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 146:7-10**

Happy are those who find solace in God, the help of the poor.

**Second Reading: 1 Timothy 6:11-16**

St. Paul exhorts Timothy to stay faithful to God in all things.

**Gospel Reading: Luke 16:19-31**

Jesus tells the parable of the reversal of fortunes between the rich man and the poor man, Lazarus.

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

In today's reading from the Gospel of St Luke, Jesus gives us the vivid and moving parable of the rich man and Lazarus. It is a story full of memorable images: we can picture the rich man in all his purple finery; poor and hungry Lazarus with his sores being licked by the dogs; the flames and the torment that the rich man endures; and Lazarus in peace in the bosom of Abraham.

In addition to this rich imagery, this parable is memorable for another reason. If we reflect for a moment on all the other parables in the Gospels, we realise that none of the protagonists are named: not even the most famous, such as the Prodigal Son or the Good Samaritan. There may be a reason for this: the fact that these characters are nameless emphasises the universality of the parables' moral implications. It is curious, then, that in today's parable Jesus specifically gives one of the



characters – the poor man – a name. Why does he do this?

One possibility is that Jesus wishes to reverse the world's normal attitude to wealth and poverty. Money and riches usually denote status; our culture teaches us to revere the well off and aspire to emulate their lifestyles. Because the rich man in today's parable is un-named, we recognise the essential lack of humanity in his outlook.

Those who are poor – whether materially, physically, or intellectually – are more likely to be marginalised by the wider society. By naming the poor man in today's parable – Lazarus – Jesus gives a face and a voice to someone who might otherwise go unnoticed. He personalises Lazarus, restores his dignity. It is easy to walk past a nameless beggar; more difficult to do so if we know the name by which we acknowledge his personhood.

**TWO IMPORTANT PIECES OF CATHOLIC NEWS FOR THIS AUTUMN:** The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have designated 2020 as **'The God Who Speaks': A Year of the Word** to celebrate the 10th anniversary of *Verbum Domini*- Pope Benedict XVI's Apostolic Exhortation on 'The Word of the Lord', and the 1600th anniversary of death of St Jerome, who translated the Bible into Latin. This Year will begin with the Feast day of Saint Jerome on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019. There will be groups and activities throughout the parishes. More news as resources and programmes become available. Therefore, 2020 will be a year of **celebrating, living and sharing God's Word**: *We are invited to listen afresh to the word of God as did Our Blessed Lady at the Annunciation, to encounter anew the presence of that word, and to proclaim it afresh in the Church and the World.*

**CARDINAL JOHN HENRY NEWMAN WILL BE MADE A SAINT LATER THIS YEAR.** Pope Francis has announced the date of the canonisation as 13 October. He will be the first English saint since the Forty Martyrs were canonised in 1970, after being executed under Reformation laws. Cardinal Vincent Nichols said it was a "moment of great pride". During his life, Newman was a respected religious scholar, who spent much of his time helping the poor and sick.
