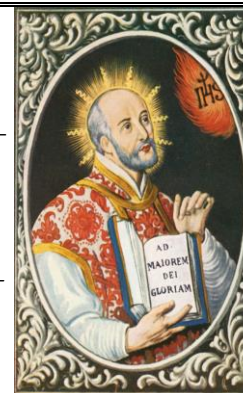
Feast Day of our Patron St Ignatius of Loyola
