- 1. Please **Sign up** for the setup and clear up rota. The parents of each child should sign up for three slots each on a first come first serve basis.

- 3. Parish office has still NOT received **payments** from some parents for the Reconciliation book (£15) which your child has received.
- 4. Mass Attendance card:
- a. Stickers are issued to FHC children before Mass on Saturdays and Sundays. The child should be present for Mass with his/her card.
- b. Sticker will not be issued if your child is not present for Mass, has forgotten to bring the card to Mass, has missed to attend Mass or collect sticker.
- c. Please make sure that the Attendance Card has the Child's full name, this will help the Stewards to identify the card and in case its lost. If you find a lost card, please drop it into the Rectory letter box or give it to Fr Christian or the Stewards.

#### **FR CHRISTIAN WRITES**

This Sunday, "Laetare Sunday" as it is usually called, marks the official half way point of our Laetare journey. The word "Laetare" means "rejoice" because today we remember that while our journey from sin to new life in Christ can often be sorrowful, it is all pointing towards the joy of redemption.

During Lent we rightly hear a lot about the need for sorrow for our sins. This is not about morbidly fixating on our past failures but about examining our consciences to make sure we see when we have failed and recognising the need for justice. On the cross we see revealed the true reality of what sin is in the sight of God. His perfection when confronted with evil.

But this is where we bring in the "rejoice". While we know that we have sinned, and that we rightly weep both for those sins and the sins of the world, Christ has not come to condemn the world but to save it. The cross reveals the horror of sin to us, but it is inextricably linked to the resurrection. The resurrection, which is the complete revelation of the heart of God Himself, beyond His justice or even our conception of what perfection would mean: the mystery of His loving mercy.
