

The Upper Room, Mary and the Mission of the Church

Today we celebrate the last Sunday of Eastertide and next Sunday we will celebrate Pentecost. How do you and I prepare to receive the Holy Spirit?

Last Thursday we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord and the Apostles saw the Lord ascending to heaven. They remained staring at the clouds with sad faces, but they were comforted by the angel that assured them that the one who had ascended into heaven will come again in the same way as he ascended. Furthermore, the Lord Jesus told them that the Holy Spirit will come to them to make them witnesses of the Risen Lord and will proclaim the Good News of this new life in Christ to the whole world. (cf. Acts 1:11) The Apostles went to join Mary at the place where the Lord celebrated the Last Supper in the Upper Room which we know it as the Cenacle. They did what the Lord asked them to do, that is, to wait for the Holy Spirit who will give them power to be witnesses to the Resurrection and the new life we have got in Jesus the Lord. They have been given a huge mission which they could not have been able to accomplish by themselves. They were getting ready to fulfill such great mission the Lord gave them by gathering in prayer and asking for the Holy Spirit to come upon them. They did not just wait in idleness or just expecting things to happen like magic but they brought their whole lives, their fears and concerns, all their desires to do God's will and share the experience of the new life they have seen and heard from Jesus during his earthly life. They in a way, brought in prayer their inadequacy for the task and their worries and anxieties to face such big task. They learnt to trust in the Lord with the help of Mary, his mother supporting them in prayer besides them.

Today the Church invites you and I, to enter into the Upper Room with Mary and the Apostles and prepare ourselves to receive the Holy Spirit in our lives so that we may be able to fulfil our mission in the Church for the world, to proclaim the Gospel of the new life the Lord has given to us. Bring your fears, your concerns and anxieties to the Upper Room. Bring your whole life with all your joys and sadness, your anxieties and fears. Bring your sufferings and your petitions before the Lord who will give you a new spirit to face the daily realities you are struggling with to accept and embrace it.

Let us enter into the Upper Room with Mary and the Apostles and wait in prayer praying the Novena to the Holy Spirit who wants to fill our lives with his gifts to help us fulfill our mission as disciples of Christ.
