

21st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

YEAR A- 27/08/2023

"Who do you say I am?"

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus puts this personal question to his disciples and therefore, to you and to me too. What would your answer be? Perhaps you have experienced a difficulty in answering to this question in a personal manner and most likely you have tried to answer it by listing the titles by which Jesus is known such us, He is the Son of God, the Saviour, the Redeemer, the Healer, etc.

Some people would say that Jesus was a revolutionary teacher who has taught high values but not the Son of God. This would be like answering to Jesus's first question, 'who do people say I am' rather than the second one, 'who do **you** say I am.' We know St Peter's response he said, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.' As we know, St Peter was always quick to answer to the Lord. But this time he got it right. He was inspired by the Father to make such profession of faith in the divinity of Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God. Jesus has recognised the faith of Peter and made him the "Rock" on which He has founded the Church that has as its visible head, the Pope. We believe that the Pope is the successor of St Peter, and Jesus Christ has given him the keys of the Kingdom. Pope Francis often gives testimony of his faith like Peter, through his preaching, his writings, and his actions.

Today the Church invites us to place ourselves sitting down with the disciples of Jesus, listening to the Lord's personal question that summons a sincere response from our part. The response we give is a profession of faith in Jesus Christ, not a merely intellectual or lip's profession of faith but a profession of faith substantiated by concrete facts of the things and events in which, we have seen and experienced God's salvific action in our lives. Let us take courage and overcome our fear to speak about our faith in Jesus Christ to our children, relatives, colleagues, and any of our neighbours. This week let us take some time of silence, to meditate on Jesus's personal question "Who do you say I am" and give our personal answer to the Lord. Let us profess our faith in him with sincerity of heart.
