

24th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR A- 17/09/2023

To be forgiven, you must forgive

On this Sunday's readings we continue reflecting on the theme of forgiveness. Last Sunday was about the fraternal correction and forgiveness within the community. This Sunday is focus on the personal level of forgiveness of an offence. Peter asks Jesus. 'Lord, how often must I forgive my brother if he wrongs me? As often as seven times?' Jesus answered, 'Not seven, I tell you, but seventy-seven times. This means to forgive always, there is no limit of times to forgive. This forgiveness reflects the forgiveness of God who in his mercy "forgive us our trespasses" always, as we pray in the Lord's prayer. The parable of the unforgiving servant reflects that reality of God's great patience and forgiveness. God (the king) cancels the astronomical debt of the servant, which could be around 164,000 days wages, (like a billion sterling pounds) a debt the servant could never repay it! However, the merciless response of the servant who did not forgive his fellow's small debt, the equivalent to 100 days wages, shows that he has not learnt the lesson of patience, mercy and forgiveness he has received from the king (God). This is a lesson for us. God has forgiven us so much, so that we can forgive our offenders. We have received the forgiveness from Jesus Christ crucified on the cross. Remember his words on the cross, 'Father forgive them; they do not know what they do' (Lk 23:34). Forgiveness is a grace which the Lord has given us in his Son, Jesus. It would be foolish to try to achieve forgiveness with our own human strength as an act of will power. Forgiveness is one of the most difficult things to give and receive.

In our prayer, let us ask the Lord to show us who we are and with humility recognise our frailty, our ingratitude, our selfishness, in other words, our sinfulness and ask the Lord for forgiveness and we will experience that our debt, our huge debt, is remitted by the grace of Jesus Christ sacrificed on the cross.

Have you got anyone in your debt? Pray, meditate, ask the Lord to help you to go and ask for forgiveness before it's too late.

Have you got any resentment in your heart? Do not let this ruin an embittered your life, go and be reconciled with that person and show the same mercy that the Father has shown us.
