

## 'I am the handmaid of the Lord, let what you have said be done to me'

This is "yes" of Mary to do the will of God. The "yes" to conceive within her Jesus the Son of God. The yes of Mary is the door that has opened the way to the fulfilment of God's loving plan of salvation already announced in the prophesies of the Old Testament. Her "yes" entailed accepting great personal sacrifices and even with fatal consequences. For instance, her "yes" entailed she would be pregnant as an unwed mother and betrothed to someone who wasn't the father. She could have been stoned to death as part of the law of her community. Saying 'yes' was an act of trust, saying 'yes' to God, over and beyond what looked reasonable, possible or safe by the outer circumstances.

The "yes" of Mary was not a passive yes, or a consent with resignation but it was a yes that means "bring it on, I am ready for it. I am ready to risk even my life to do it!

This is the model of the believer's response. On this last Sunday of Advent, Mary is portrayed as the model of our spirituality and prayer. We are called to hear the word of God, the Good News (Gospel) from the Lord through the Church. It is up to us to respond with faith or to be afraid of accepting God's will. The Lord says, 'do not be afraid Mary, the Holy Spirit will come upon you.' God will not let us walk alone! The Lord will always provide the way, the means, the graces for us to accomplish our mission as Mary.

Your "yes" to believe and do the will of God, is vital for the salvation of the world, our neighbours and ours too! What is the Lord asking you to say yes to? May be to give up resentful feelings and forgive and heal your relationship with your family relatives with who you have fallen out for some reason. May be the Lord's will be to take a risk and get married next year! Or may be to have more children!

As we prepare to celebrate the Nativity of Jesus tonight, let us ask the Lord to help us to have the courage to believe like Mary, so that we may be able to say yes to God's will and be of service to our neighbours, our community and family.

Let us look forward to celebrate Christmas tonight and say "yes" to let the light of the Lord enter into our lives, our hearts, our homes and every sphere of our human lives that it may bring warmth, love, understanding, comfort, healing, forgiveness and salvation to us and to all whom we live and work with and share our lives daily.

Rejoice, rejoice, Emmanuel God-is-with-us. He has been born in Bethlehem for us. Let us give Glory to him with Mary, Joseph, the humble shepherds and the angels in heaven.
