

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR B 25/02/2024

The Transfiguration of the Lord The Church through this Sunday's readings invites us to come to the high mountain to meet the

Lord with Peter, James and John and contemplate the Lord's transfiguration. The word

"Transfiguration" in Greek, "Metamorphosis" means a change of form or appearance into a more beautiful or spiritual state. For us Christians, the Transfiguration of the Lord means, the transformation of our lives in Jesus Christ by his death and Resurrection which we received by virtue of our baptism, as the Catechism of the Catholic Church says "...On the threshold of the Passover: the Transfiguration. Jesus' baptism proclaimed "the mystery of the first regeneration" namely, our Baptism; the Transfiguration "is the sacrament of the second regeneration": our own Resurrection. From now on we share in the Lord's Resurrection through the Spirit who acts in the sacraments of the Body of Christ. The Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he "will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body." But it also recalls that "it is through many persecutions that we must enter the kingdom of God" (CCC 556). This time of Lent, the Church invites us to recall the gift of our baptism in Jesus Christ and climb into the mountain with the apostles Peter, James and John to enter into the cloud, which means the presence of God, as it was the encounter of Moses in mount Sinai. There the Lord spoke to Moses face to face (Exodus 19-20) and gave him the Ten Commandments for Israel to live their new life in the Lord. Similarly, the Lord spoke to Elijah on a mountain (cf. 1kings 19:11-18) in moments of trial and persecution, when he was exhausted and wanted for being prophet of the Lord. We enter into the cloud of the presence of the Lord to listen to his "Word" that is, Jesus our Lord. We do this by following the voice of the Lord that says, 'This is my Son, the beloved, listen to him.' So, let us get away from all distractions the world offers us, and enter into the presence of the Lord in prayer, with attentive ears and hearts ready to listen and willing to do the will of God. Let us enter into this time of purification, from all our vices and toxic habits that prevent us entering into a loving relationship with God and neighbour. Come before the presence of the Lord carrying all your burdens and anxieties and rest in him, here on the mountain of the Lord, that is the Church. Let us come to his presence fixing our eyes on the Lord's Transfiguration that remind us of the victory of the Lord over death by his Resurrection. Let us keep the image of the transfigured Lord, that gives us hope and encourages us to let the Holy Spirit work, transform and renew our lives, so that we may be able to irradiate the love and
