

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER 14/04/2024 YEAR B

Easter season, 50 days of living and sharing the Good News

We are living on the 3rd week of Easter and we are leading towards the celebration of Pentecost, the day on which the Holy Spirit came upon Mary and the Apostles. Throughout these 50 days of Easter, we proclaim and listen the testimony that the Apostles give about the Resurrection of Christ, for which they are threaten, put in jail, and punished for their courage of preaching the Resurrection of Christ, whose sacrifice on the cross has brought the gift of forgiveness of sins, not only the sins of the Jewish people living in Jerusalem alone but also our sins and the sins of the whole world (cf 1John 2:1-5). This is the Good News (Gospel) that the Apostles announced it on the streets, the Temple of Jerusalem, private houses and the Synagogues.

On these 50 days of Easter, we are called to bear witness to the Resurrection of Christ by proclaiming with our lips and deeds, the forgiveness of our sins not only by turning to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, but also by asking God to help us to forgive those who we are keeping them in our debt or holding grudges against.

The forgiveness of sins is the fruit of the death and Resurrection of Christ, who made

The forgiveness of sins is the fruit of the death and Resurrection of Christ, who made for us possible to experience the mercy of God and be united in one body, in the Church, our family and our community. This is called in Greek "Koinonia" which means that there is a unity created by the Holy Spirit called "Communion" with Jesus Christ as well with our brothers and sisters in Christ. In other words, we have been made partakers in the unity of love of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (The Holy Trinity). This unity helps us to love and be united with our neighbours.

This Sunday the Lord again, invites us to sit at the table of the Eucharist where Jesus will break the bread of his Body to make us partakers in his divine life with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We hope that we will recognise him at the breaking of the bread today, receive the forgiveness of our sins and receive life from Him. We, as the forgiven children of God, can approach the table of the Lord with gratitude for having been forgiven and loved.
