Whilst I could take some time to break down this myth, I will save that for the Autumn. In the meantime, let me encourage you by saying that volunteering in youth ministry doesn't always mean speaking directly to young people. There are the ministries of the kitchen, of IT, of hospitality and of general organisation - all of which are just as important as the ministry of 'presence' that is the most obvious.
