33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time - Page 164 in the Parish Mass Book

First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20. — "Lo, the day is coming, blazing like an oven, when all the proud and all evildoers will be stubble, and the day that is coming will set them on fire, leaving them neither root nor branch, says the Lord of Hosts"

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 98: "The Lord comes to rule the peoples with fairness."

Second Reading – 2 Thessalonians 3:7 -12 – "you know how one must imitate us. For we did not act in a disorderly way among you, nor did we eat food received from anyone"

Gospel - Luke 21:5 - 19: "All that you see here – the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

The readings for the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C make us think about the end of the world. In the first reading we are told that the day of the Lord is coming. The psalm assures us that "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice." In the second reading Paul asks that we diligently work for the good of all. In the gospel Jesus speaks about the times and perseverance.
