Second Reading – First Letter of St. Paul to Timothy 6:11.16. In these verses St Paul is exhorting Timothy to strive to become daily more perfect in his observance of the Christian faith.

The Gospel – St Luke 16:19-31. We have here a story of two men whose states, both in this life and in the next, are dramatically opposed.
