

# CORPUS CHRISTI, TRING

Third Sunday of Advent – Pg. 88 in the Parish Mass Book – 10/11<sup>th</sup> December



The Third Sunday of Advent is also known as Gaudete Sunday, the word "Gaudet" is derived from the Latin word "Gaudium" joy and "gaudeo" to rejoice or be glad. Gaudete Sunday occurs eight to thirteen days before Christmas, and the nearness of the feast is reason for great joy. Rose represents joy and may be used as the liturgical colour for Gaudete Sunday.

**First Reading: Isaiah:** 3.5 1- 6, 10 – Those whom the Lord has ransomed will return and enter Zion singing, crowned with everlasting joy; they will meet with joy, gladness. Sorrow and mourning will flee.

Responsorial Psalm: — Psalm 146 "Lord come and save us"

**Second Reading:** James 5:7 – 10 "See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, begin patient with it until it receives the early and late rains"

Gospel: – Matthew 11:2-11 "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me"
