


CORPUS CHRISTI, TRING

5TH Sunday of Lent - Page 170 - Fírst Reading: Ezekiel 37:12-14 Responsoral Psalm - Psalm 129, Second Reading: Romans 8: 8-11, Gospel John 11:1-45



<u>First Reading: Ezekiel 37:12-14:</u> The prophet Ezekiel is given a vision of a valley filled with dry bones, which represent the people of Israel who are dead in their exile. The Lord promises to put his spirit within them and restore them to life, bringing them back to their own land.

<u>Responsorial Psalm</u> – Psalm 129 This is a psalm of supplication and trust in the Lord's mercy and redemption. The psalmist cries out to the Lord from the depths and acknowledges that with the Lord there is forgiveness and redemption, and encourages Israel to wait for the Lord and trust in his word.

<u>Second Reading</u> – Romans 8: 8-11: Paul teaches that those who live according to the flesh cannot please God, but those who live according to the Spirit have the Spirit of Christ within them and will have life. He declares that the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead dwells within believers and gives life to their mortal bodies.

<u>Gospel - John 11: 1-45:</u> Jesus received news that his friend Lazarus is seriously ill, but waits to visit him until after he has died. When Jesus arrives, he raises Lazarus from the dead, demonstrating his power over death and prompting many to believe in him.
