First Reading: Zechariah 9:9-10 – “See now, your King comes humbly to you”

‘Rejoice heart and soul, daughter of Zion! Shout with gladness, daughter of Jerusalem! See now, your King comes to you, he is victorious, he is triumphant, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 144:1-2,8-11,13-14 - I will bless your name for ever, O God my King

Second Reading: Romans 8:9, 11-13 – “If by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body, you will live”
