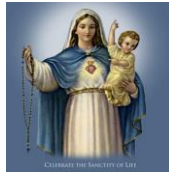




CORPUS CHRISTI, TRING

October is the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our most gracious advocate.

The Mysteries of the Holy Rosary – Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious & Luminous - reflect the mysteries of our own lives as well.

First Reading: Isaiah 5: 1 -7 - Yes, the vineyard of the Lord of Hosts is the House of Israel, and the men of Judah that chosen plant. He expected justice, but found bloodshed, integrity but only a cry of distress.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 79:9 12 -16, 19-20 The vineyard of the Lord is the House of Israel
