<u>First Reading</u> – Isaiah 60: 1-6 – Above you Yahweh now rises and above you his glory appears. The nations come to your light and kings to your dawning brightness.

Responsorial Psalm - Psalm 71: 1-2, 7-87,10.13 - All nations fall prostrate before you, O Lord.

<u>Second Reading</u> – Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6 – This mystery that has now been revealed through the Spirit to his holy apostles and prophets was unknown to any men in past generations; it means that pagans now share the same inheritance.

Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12 - 'At Bethlehem in Judaea' they told him 'for this is what the prophet wrote'.

'And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah,
you are by no means least among the leaders of Judah,
for out of you will come a leader
who will shepherd my people Israel'.
