


CORPUS CHRISTI, TRING

<u>First Reading</u> – 1 Samuel 3:3-10, 19 – Samuel had as yet no knowledge of Yahweh and the word of Yahweh had not yet been revealed to him. Once again Yahweh called, the third time. He got up and went to Eli and said 'Here I am, since you called me'. Eli then understood that it was Yahweh who was calling the boy, and he said to Samuel 'Go and lie down, and if someone calls say," Speak, Yahweh, your servant is listening"

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 392, 4,7-10 - Here I am Lord! I come to do you will.

<u>Second Reading</u> – 1 Corinthians 6:13-15, 17-20 - You know, surely, that your bodies are members making up the body of Christ; but anyone who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with him.

<u>Gospel</u> – John 1: 35-42 – They answered, 'Rabbi' – which means Teacher – 'where do you live?' 'Come and see' he replied; so, they went and saw where he lived, and stayed with him the rest of that day.
