<u>First Reading: Genesis 9: 8-15</u> – See I establish my Covenant with you and your descendants after you; also, with every living creature to be found with you, birds, cattle and everything that lives on the earth.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 24: 4-9 - Your ways, Lord, are faithfulness and love for those who keep your covenant.

<u>1 Peter 3: 18-22</u> – That water is a type of the baptism which saves you now, and which is not the washing off of physical dirt but a pledge made to God from a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Gospel: Mark 1 – 12-15 – Immediately afterwards the Spirit drove him out into the wilderness and he remained there for forty days, and was tempted by Satan. He was with the wild beasts, and the angels looked after him.
