"They were still talking about all this when Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you!'" (Luke 24:36)

Those words of Jesus Christ to his downcast disciples taken from this Sunday's Gospel passage, were just what they needed at the time. They had already given up hope after the loss of their Lord and Master, albeit momentarily, to the persecution and his execution on the cross by the elders and the chief priests. This bequeath of divine peace and sharing a meal with the disciples, was a concrete assurance that Christ has truly risen. It was also the testament of the peace with God that Jesus wrought for humanity who separated itself from God through sin.

The need for peace, reconciliation and healing, even in today's world, cannot be over-emphasised. We hear about it on the radio; see it on the television; read it on news prints and through other means.

Like the disciples, we too can get overwhelmed by disappointments and things not going as we expect them in life. It is easy to give up, but perseverance is always the best amour to put on. One thing we can be sure of is that the risen Lord will never abandon us. He is ever standing in our midst, even as the worries of life and the situations we find ourselves in try distract us. He is here with us calling us to embrace the new life that he brings. To listen to his voice and follow where he leads us is in our best interest and the path to living a peaceful life.

I come therefore to share with you the peace which Christ bequeaths, having been sent to you by the Archbishop, Cardinal Vincent Nichols, as the Parochial Administrator of Corpus Christi Parish. Let us therefore strive to make the reconciliation, healing and peace that the risen Christ brought humanity through his death and resurrection, a living experience for all in our parish. Let us pray for one another and for Fr Sean, as we wish him God's blessings.
