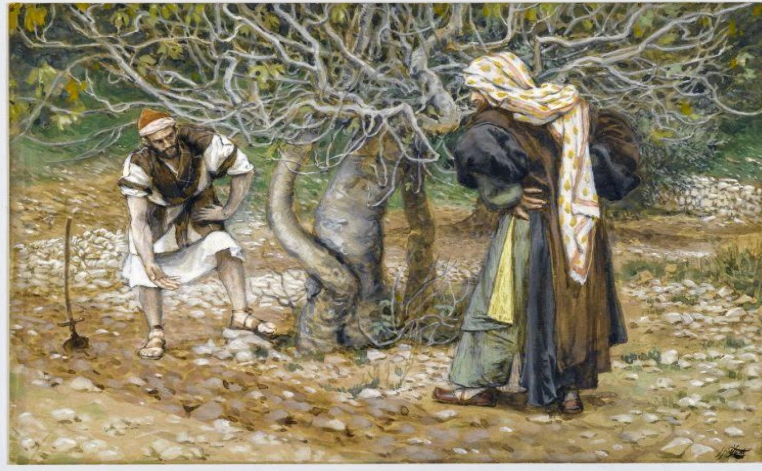

First Reading – Acts 9:26-31 – Barnabas, however, took charge of him and introduced him to the apostles, and explained how the Lord had appeared to Saul and spoken to him on his journey.

Responsorial Psalm – You, Lord, are my praise in the great assembly.

Second Reading – 1 John 3:18 -24 His commandments are these: that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and that we love one another as he told us to.

Gospel: John 15: 1 – 8 – Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty; for cut off from me you can do nothing.
