'Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.'

As always on this first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is the central mystery of our faith – our God, one in three persons, in whose name we were all welcomed at our baptism.

When the Church celebrates the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, it is an attempt to summarise in one day the communion of love of the triune God divinely revealed through God's creation and in the history of human salvation and sanctification. This is not just a "theological feast" but a feast which should speak to us of this simple fact of faith: the Father loves us, has revealed that love in his Son, and has called us into a relationship sustained by the Spirit.

It is our joy that, as baptised members of the Church, we can somehow share in that divine life and love which is the Trinity - becoming children of God. God has chosen us, and we are his own people, just as he chose the people of Israel long ago. The mystery of the Trinity is not meant to make this more difficult. On the contrary it is to clarify and summarise all that our faith is about: that we are children - with the Son, in the power of the Spirit - of the one Father.

This week, we pray that filled with God's Spirit, we will be ready and willing to share the Holy Trinity's message of love with the people we meet to the glory of God the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
