COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS

The Bishops of England and Wales have decided that it is now safe for people to receive Communion under Both Kinds (to receive the Precious Blood from the Chalice, as well as receiving the Host), as we did before the start of COVID Pandemic. Their intention is that we should resume offering the Chalice at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, and then at every Mass thereafter. But before we take this step, we need to know what people think about this proposal.
