NEW PARISH SAFEGUARDING REPRESENTATIVE (PSR)

Carmelina Tona has recently been appointed the PSR for Waltham Cross Parish. An important part of Carmelina's role is to work with the whole parish to promote good practices and to implement statutory policies and procedures in all safeguarding activities, involving children and vulnerable adults within the Parish. PSRs are the first point of contact for the Parish community should anyone wish to disclose a safeguarding concern, such as abuse against a child or vulnerable adult.

The role also encompasses the safe recruitment of anyone who wishes to work/volunteer in the Parish with groups of children and/or adults at risk, including the initial processing of DBS applications and DBS rechecks.

We have recently undertaken an audit of the DBS status of our volunteers. Those volunteers whose DBS check is out of date will be contacted in the next few weeks, so that rechecks can be undertaken.
