- A reunion for old parishioners and pupils of St Patrick's school.

- An exhibition by the artists in the studios.
- Invitation to the Cardinal for Mass.
- Restoration of the hidden wall paintings on the east wall and general redecoration in the church.
- An "open day" for the non-Catholic residents of Wapping.
