Our archbishop, Cardinal Nichols, ordained six new priests for our diocese at the Cathedral on Saturday: Frs Allan Alvarado, Mark Duglinson, Daniel Herrero, Rajiv Michael, Jonathan Stogdon and John Tabor. There will be a further priestly ordination of Antonio Pineda later in July. These new priests are a gift from the Lord. Please pray for their new ministries and for more vocations to the priesthood.

On Monday, 2nd July, I celebrate my own anniversary of ordination – 7 years ago I was given this same gift and responsibility. Although not that long in the grand scheme of things, I find it hard to remember what my life was like before I was a priest. I am increasingly conscious of the importance of the love, prayer and support I receive from the People of God. I am very grateful to you all. If you have time, please say a prayer for me on Monday, and for our shared mission here in Wapping.

Grant Application for the Old School

This weekend we submitted our application for funding to begin the renovation of the old school. We have asked for £127,650 to refurbish the hall and entrance areas, and provide a kitchen and accessible toilet facilities. The Buildings Committee hopes that this is just the first phase in transforming the old school into our new St Patrick's Community Hall. In July we will find out if we have been shortlisted, and a final decision will be made in October. Please remember this project in your prayers.

I would like to thank our Buildings Committee for the huge amount of work in putting together the application so quickly. And thank you for the contributions to our community consultation. Nearly 200 questionnaires were completed in total.

There is a copy of the plans on the noticeboard in the porch and on the website.

I am away from Monday for a fortnight, but will remember you in prayer. Fr Andrew.
