FR ANDREW WRITES:

Government COVID-19 Response Roadmap: Step 4 Guidance

The bishops have issued guidance as we move into "Step 4" on 19th July. Despite the removal of COVID-19 legislation, we must still ensure that the church is a safe environment and, for now, much in our parish will stay as it is.

Booking for Mass. From next weekend, it is no longer necessary to register in advance for Sunday Mass. During these quieter summer months, we remain below our present safe capacity. You are asked still to check-in using the NHS Covid-19 app, as you would in restaurants and other venues.

Masks, although no longer a legal requirement from Monday, are still recommended in church to reduce aerosol and droplet spread. There are legitimate exemptions, and no one should be asked to explain themselves if they are not wearing a mask.

Congregational singing is permitted from 19th July, but we will phase it in gradually after the summer.

More information to come in the weeks ahead. For now we continue as we have been.

Fr Alan Griffin RIP

Fr Alan Griffin died 8th November 2020. He was a priest of the Ordinariate and lived in retirement in Wapping for many years, covering Masses here in the parish as needed. He died by suicide. I did not share this at the time, and I do so now because it was reported by the BBC News on Friday, following the outcome of the inquest into his death. The Coroner identified failings in the safeguarding services of the Church of England and our own Catholic Archdiocese of Westminster, and these formed the basis of the news article. The statement from the Diocese of Westminster:

We express our sorrow and dismay at the death of Fr Alan Griffin. We extend our condolences to his family and friends. This has been a great shock to us all. We are grateful to the work of the Coroner in bringing to light the complex circumstances of this tragic situation and we acknowledge the coroner's conclusions. We are cooperating fully with the Catholic Standards Safeguarding Agency in its review so that every lesson can be learned from this tragedy.

It saddens me greatly that Fr Alan's death might have been avoided. Please pray for the happy repose of his soul, and for the Lord to send his healing to all who have been affected. I am happy to discuss this and answer any questions you might have.

In the meantime, they recognise that it is still not possible for all the faithful to attend on Sundays. Please judge for yourselves. If you can attend Mass in person, and it is safe for you, you are encouraged to do so.
