150th Anniversary Mass and Parish Fair: Sunday 17th October

The parish of Wapping was founded in October 1871, making next month the 150th anniversary. Bishop Nicholas Hudson is coming to celebrate the 10am Mass on Sunday 17th October, followed by a parish fair (weather permitting!). Please save the date!

Welcome Back

A warm welcome back to those families who have been away over the summer. I have included in my prayers and in my offerings at Mass all parishioners beginning a new term at work and school, and ask the Lord to give the gifts of the Holy Spirit to you all.

Sunday Obligation

The obligation for Catholics to attend Mass on Sundays and holydays is still suspended. The bishops of England and Wales hope that it will be possible for all Catholics to return to Mass by the First Sunday of Advent 2021. In the meantime, they recognise that it is still not possible for some. That said, it's important to restore Sunday Mass to its rightful centrality in our lives, and to rekindle in our hearts a yearning for the Real Presence of the Lord in the Eucharist. Please judge for yourselves. If it is safe for you to attend Mass in person, you are encouraged to do so.

No Wednesday Mass

There will no longer be Mass on Wednesdays in the parish. Wednesday is my day off. In the past, Fr Alan Griffin, may he rest in peace, said Wednesday morning Mass. Since the start of the pandemic (and without the possibility of going anywhere!), I have said it myself. Now, I have decided to say Mass privately on Wednesdays, so I am free to be away from the parish. With the Jesuits moved away, there is no other priest nearby to cover. There is Mass on Wednesdays at St Mary and St Michael, Commercial Road, at 9.30am; at English Martyrs, Tower Hill, at 1.00pm; and St Mary Moorfields (by Liverpool Street station) at 1.05pm.
