## FR ANDREW WRITES:

### **The Founding of Wapping Parish (1871)**

The Archbishop of Westminster, Cardinal Manning, had a great interest and a father's love for the poor people of the docks. In October 1871, 150 years ago this month, he appointed a young priest, Fr David Hickey, as Rector of a new mission in Wapping. Fr Hickey went straight to work caring for the people of his new parish and celebrating Mass in the school. It would be another eight years before the parish of Wapping had its own church. Fr Hickey set his sights on the old workhouse. It was his successor, Fr Angelo Lucas, who eventually purchased the land in 1877 and built St Patrick's.

### **150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**

So, today, we celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Wapping parish. The church building is still only 142 years old! It is a pleasure to welcome Bishop Nicholas Hudson to celebrate a Mass of thanksgiving for all the graces and benefits the Good Lord has bestowed on our parish over these past 150 years.

Holy Church is made of living stones: disciples of Jesus Christ baptised into his Body. Our impoverished forebears in Wapping sacrificed greatly to build such a proud church and three school buildings, out of love of the Lord Jesus and his Church. Ever since, our parish has flourished by the grace of God and the generosity of priests and people, working together, and the same is still true of our parishioners today. I am grateful before God for each one of you.

This celebration is also an opportunity to entrust the future of our parish to the Lord. We are renewing the call to missionary discipleship and committed to growing the Body of Christ in Wapping. As you know, we also have major works planned for our parish buildings. All of this needs the Lord's grace.

### **Parish Fair**

The parish fair will follow Mass, in the playground and Parish Centre, accessed via the passageway by the church entrance. There will be homemade food, a bar, arts and crafts for children, entertainment from Pollyanna, books and gifts, Christmas cards, games and more. Please come and support the fair. All the proceeds will go towards our 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary fund, for the refurbishment of the parish buildings.

A huge amount of work goes on to prepare for an event like this. A sincere thank you for the generosity of so many. Our community is blessed indeed to have you all.
