CELEBRATING **150** YEARS 1871-2021

FR ANDREW WRITES:

First Holy Communion Thanksgiving

This Sunday 10am Mass, we welcome the children who received the Blessed Eucharist for the first time in the past year. Due to the various restrictions in place at the time, they made their First Holy Communions at small celebrations on different days. It is good to be together, again, to give thanks to God for gifting himself to them in Holy Communion.

There is a party in the parish hall after the Mass, at which the children will receive their certificates. Everyone is welcome to celebrate with them.

Drainage Works and Porch Steps

Later this week, work will begin to reinstate the drains along the north wall of the church (beneath the cobbles on Green Bank). The present drainage system has failed, leading to rainwater from the church roof flowing into the ground. Our structural engineer believes that this is contributing to the floor movement in the north aisle of the church. You will notice that the worst of the floor sinkage is around St Joseph and the confessional by the baptistry, corresponding to the downpipes on the outside north wall. The new drainage should remedy the problem and prevent it recurring when eventually we lay a new floor in the church.

The main porch steps will be lifted and re-laid at the same time, and the damaged stones repaired or replaced. The leading edge of the steps has dropped about 5cm from level, over many years. This is all necessary work, costing the parish around £10,000 and lasting for a fortnight or so.

The church will remain open throughout the works. Access will be via the west doors to the back chapel. Thank you for your patience.

Operation Elf

Operation Elf is organised by PACT, the Prisoners Advice and Care Trust. We have supported it as a parish for many years. Christmas is a difficult time for children with parents in prison. There is renewed pain of separation and often these families struggle financially. In previous years, we have collected gifts for prisoners to give their children for Christmas. The pandemic continues to make that impossible this year.

Instead, while doing your Christmas shopping, please consider buying a £10 gift card: something a child can use to buy something they will enjoy. The Post Office sells One4All gift cards which are accepted in several shops, or you might choose a store

like Boots, M&S, John Lewis, WH Smith etc. Please £10 only! If you want to donate more, buy multiple £10 cards. It is important that these are physical gift cards, as prisoners have no way to send e-cards and e-vouchers to their children.

PACT will distribute these gift cards to prisoners to give as Christmas gifts to their children when they see them on family visit days before Christmas.

The deadline for handing in the gift cards is Sunday 28th November. Thank you for supporting this cause.
