'Christmas is joy' said the Holy Father Pope Francis and that well-known Christian hymn, Joy to the World, in its opening verse expresses succinctly what happens at Christmas, in other words the true meaning of Christmas!

St Ambrose of Milan, once taught: Open wide your door to the One who comes. Open your soul, throw open the depths of your heart to see the riches of simplicity, the treasures of peace, the sweetness of grace. Open your heart and run to meet the Sun of eternal light that illuminates all men.

Let us rejoice, dear friends, for salvation has dawned, a light has been shone in the darkness, we need no longer fear, for Jesus is near and with us.
