PENTECOST SUNDAY

19 May 2024

Zero to Fifty!

The word Pentecost means 50^{th} and for us, it marks the Descent of the Holy Spirit and the Birthday of the Church.

The Holy Spirit, as you will recall overshadowed Mary at the Annunciation and God became Incarnate and was born in our world; today, that same Spirit, descended upon the Apostles and Mary and the Church was born.

However, the descent of the Holy Spirit still happens today, at every Mass, the Priest calls down the Holy Spirit to sanctify and consecrate the Bread and Wine, transforming it substantially into the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ. This is known as the *epiclesis* and without it, there would be no Eucharist. Indeed, the Mass, has always been Trinitarian. The Priest offers to the Father the Sacrifice of the Son through the power of the Holy Spirit.

As St Peter Damian once taught: "He [The Holy Spirit] pours light into our minds, arouses our desire and gives us strength... As the soul is the life of the body, so the Holy Spirit is the life of our souls."

The gift of the Holy Spirit, then, is a reminder to us that God is with us, as Jesus promised He would be through the sending of the Paraclete, literally meaning, the one who is closest to one. We have not been abandoned by our God, rather, He dwells in and among us through the Eucharist primarily but in all of the Sacraments. Jesus assures us "Know that I am with you always, yes, until the end of the world."

On this auspicious day let our prayer be: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your Faithful and enkindle in them, the fire of

Your love. Send forth Your Spirit and we shall be created, and You shall renew the face of the earth.
