Pope Francis calls on believers of all religions to pray together on May 14 to ask God to rid the world of the pandemic and asks that the vaccines to be available to all persons threatened with infection.

Pope Francis has endorsed the call to "the believers of all the religious to unite together spiritually on May 14 in a day of prayer and fasting, to implore God to help humanity to overcome the coronavirus pandemic."

He also encouraged international cooperation to respond to the crisis, the emphasized the importance that scientific efforts to find a vaccine be put together in a "transparent and disinterested way" and that "the essential technologies be made universally available" so that every infected person may be able to receive the medical care needed.

The appeal calls on believers in God worldwide to hold "a day for fasting, prayers, and supplications" on May 14.
