Parishioners entering the church must be aware of and observe the following:

- 1) The maximum number of parishioners allowed inside the Church is 82. Additional spaces are available in the Pastoral Centre for 10 families (of average number 4). Parishioners are requested to be patient and to maintain 2m social distancing at all times as indicated outside the Church while waiting for their turn to enter
- 2) Those unable to obtain a place may stand in the car park for audio transmission of the service maintaining 2m social distancing but must wear a face mask.
- 3) Parishioners are requested to follow the instructions of the Volunteers

- 4) Social distancing with a radius of 2 metres is also to be maintained within the Church at all times
- 5) Hand gel must be applied upon entering and leaving the church
- 6) The special displayed instructions regarding candles must be observed. You are asked to light your candle as your final act before sanitising your hands and leaving the church
- 7) There must be no touching or kissing of any statue
- 8) Preference will be given to parishioners who are disabled, wheelchair bound, elderly or handicapped.
- 9) In the case of Emergency Evacuation of the Church, the instructions of the Volunteers must be followed
- 10) Parishioners with a cold, cough, fever or any Covid-19 related symptoms are asked not to enter the Church and if found to be coughing or sneezing excessively will be requested to leave the Church
- 11) The car park will be reserved for the elderly and disabled for whom 10 places will be available.
- 12) In the interests of ensuring that parishioners are accommodated as efficiently as possible the Pastoral Centre will be reserved for families with young children while the church will accept adults only.

MAKING A DONATION:

We have been asked: "How can I make my weekly contribution at this time?" Please do not drop envelopes through the presbytery door. This will help you to stay safe, in not taking unnecessary excursions outside. It will also avoid the risk of the virus being transmitted on the envelopes and currency. MASS INTENTIONS:

If you would like a Mass offered for a specific intention please book this via email to: wembley1@rcdow.org.uk giving the reason for which the Mass is intended e.g. for a deceased person, a personal intention or other reason. The name of the person requesting the Mass and a contact number is needed.

- The **OBLIGATION** to attend Mass on Sunday is still **SUSPENDED** (Bishops' Conference of England and Wales).
- Attending any weekday Mass is **SUFFICIENT** at the moment (Bishops' Conference of England and Wales).
- Mass offering and/or donation, including the planned giving envelopes can be submitted either on a Sunday or during any of the weekday Masses. Online offering/ donation is preferable, especially through Standing Order.
- There should be no sharing of the collection plate or bag during Mass. Collection boxes will be placed at the entrance and exit of the church - to be overseen by Stewards/Ushers.
- **SINGING** in the church is **SUSPENDED** until further notice
- **PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL** is **SUSPENDED** until further notice (Bishops' Conference of England and Wales).
- Holy Communion will be distributed in **SILENCE** with no dialogue between the minister and communicant (BCEW).
- **Celebration of Baptism** - Suspended until further notice (Awaiting some guidelines from the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales).
- Maximum number of participants during **wedding and funeral ceremonies in the church is 30** (BCEW)
