## **THE GOD WHO SPEAKS - YEAR OF THE WORD 2020 - SUNDAY MEDITATIONS, 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Meditate:** “Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us” we pray in the Our Father every day. The tragedy of today’s parable is the short memory of the servant. We are appalled by such behaviour without realising that we are that servant who does not forgive. The only way which will bring us to forgive is by remembering the times God has forgiven us.

**Act:** Forgiveness is not forgetfulness, on the contrary, we remember the wrong done to us and decided not to retaliate. The first step to forgiving someone is to pray for them. Think of someone you need to pray for and do so at mass today.
