THE GOD WHO SPEAKS - YEAR OF THE WORD 2020 - SUNDAY MEDITATIONS, 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Meditate: Right from the beginning coins carry an image representing the ruler who ordered them to be minted. This image refers to the ruler. When the Pharisees present the coin to Jesus to trap him, Jesus tricks them instead. In a veiled manner, he refers to the book of Genesis. Each of us was made to carry the image of God in us and to give him back what is his due. Praise and thanksgiving belong to him.

Act: A way of giving back to God our life is by praising him. Perhaps, set aside some time to thank God for the things he has given to you.
