# 10 Dec – 2<sup>ND</sup> SUNDAY OF ADVENT (B)

First reading: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11

God is coming to save his people and to open up our way into the future

Responsorial: Psalm 84:8

R: Lets us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help.

Second reading: 2 Peter 3:8-14

God gives us time to repent and so be ready to meet him when he comes

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

John the Baptist prepares the people for the coming of their Saviour

The key element in John the Baptist's preaching was the **preparation of a new people**, a distinct community, the Israel of the last times of the Day of the Lord. This was not an individualist cleaning out of sins, but encouraging people to join a new society that would be able to withstand the coming judgement because of the purity of its observance of **how the People of God should behave and live** as a group.

Jesus takes over from John, the message of the New Israel, with its twelve new foundation members. The new People can keep the Law in spirit and truth and who can rejoice because the Father loves them.

To welcome Jesus we must become the new community, the new People of God, the new Israel, the holy royal, priestly people of our baptism. This is the call of today's gospel. But this means a whole new vision of what it is to be a Christian, and abandoning any notion that Christianity is a religion system for individuals or a salvation system for individuals.

We cannot be the New People if the group is still behaving in its ways. This **new way of acting is essential** if we are to be the people of the Christ,

Advent poses us hard questions. 'Preparing a people' is far harder a task.

Advent means 'getting there together'!
