GETTING MARRIED

- In the Catholic Church in this Country: You need to contact one of your priests at least 6 months **before** the proposed date of the marriage- and provide a recent copy of your Baptism Certificate (dated within 6 months of the proposed marriage), and a copy of your Confirmation Certificate.
- In the Catholic Church Abroad: In addition to the information requested above, you will also need a letter of freedom from this Diocese, which may be obtained through your Priest.
