TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY, YEAR A 17TH SEPTEMBER, 2023

THEME: A New Lease on Life.



Most of us have experienced how difficult it is to forgive. It is almost impossible. In Old English it means "give to the uttermost," "extremely," "as far as you can go." Isn't that what it really is, going all the way? Who can forget the hurt? Yet we should. Who doesn't see and feel the scars and keep the memories? And yet we shouldn't. Think of God: when he forgives, the evil belongs to the past. It is gone. God keeps no accounts. He wants us to think only of the future. Jesus did not condemn but gave new chances. During this week, let us ask for the Lord's attitude.

MEDITATE: The familiar story of the unforgiving servant is actually a commentary on the earlier passage in Matthew's gospel, the Lord's Prayer in Chapter 6.

<u>ACT</u>: Pray for those whom you hold at a distance and begin the process of forgiving them.
