## Priest Training Fund

This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday and our second collection will support the Priest Training Fund. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 42 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 18 of whom are for our own Diocese, and two men are studying in Rome, also for our Diocese. Last year two men who studied at Allen Hall and one who studied in Rome ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests. The fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Your gift ensures we can provide training for these men responding to Christ's call to dedicate their lives to serve God's people. Please be as generous as you can. ## Parish Finances

For everyone, this has been a difficult 12 months both domestically and commercially. It has had an impact on our parish finances too.

We have just completed the Annual Financial Report, submitted to the Diocese. A few basic figures show the impact of lockdown etc.

Between 2019 and 2020 income dropped as follows:-

Envelopes	47,000 → 28,000
Loose plate	22,000 → 12,000
Car Park Rent	64,000 → 21,000
Overall	250,000 → 171,000

Income from Bankers Orders have not decreased so dramatically, and those who contribute in that way owe our gratitude.

Gift Aid has also been an invaluable help at this time, with thanks to all who as Tax payers have signed up to this.

If anyone in the past has Gift Aided and now no longer pays British Tax, would you kindly inform the Parish Office for our bookkeeper to adjust the records. Also, please inform us of any change of address – and also any new telephone number for the parish registers.

**Children's Liturgy** is posted each weekend on the parish Facebook page in the form of a PowerPoint presentation – do take time to watch it with your young children. **Sacramental Groups** – please pray for the children and young people, their families and the catechists in the First Confession and Holy Communion group and in the Confirmation group as they prepare for the sacraments with at-home lessons and online working.

We hope to arrange Confirmation in the mid-Summer, June/July when a Bishop is available.

On **Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> May** from 1.00pm to 3.00pm in the Parish Hall, there will be a **sale of new/once used Holy Communion outfits**, both for boys and girls. Please contact Angela Soave on 07900 903799 to arrange a time to see/try on the outfits with your child. Also on sale will be items and cards from the Repository for First Holy Communion and Confirmation, **plus** after 9am Mass on each Sunday morning during the coming weeks the Repository will be open in the Church garden-Hall (if wet) for purchase of Sacramental cards and gifts. We look forward to seeing you there.

**Sacramental preparation for summer 2022 for children attending non-Catholic Schools** – please contact Winnie Brady on 07702 094650 for details of preparation materials and to enrol your child ahead of next year's courses for First Sacraments and Confirmation.

**Youth Leader Course – Rise Up** - for any practising Catholic aged 15 (Year 11) to 21 who lives, works or studies in the Diocese of Westminster. Taking place from **September to December 2021**, You will be coached to give a 15-minute talk to an audience of your choice at the end of the project having chosen a subject matter you are passionate about. There is an opportunity to

achieve a nationally recognised qualification, a Level 1 Certificate in Exploring Youth work, through Need2Succeed (our training partner for *Rise Up*).

The Cardinal will be celebrating a live-streamed Mass for all couples in the Diocese who are celebrating their 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup> and 60<sup>th</sup> (and every year over 60) wedding anniversary of Catholic marriage in 2021. If you are celebrating an anniversary, please give your parish clergy/parish office the following details: husband and wife's names, wedding date, full postal address and email (or telephone number if no email), and these details will be sent to those organizing this celebration.
