## **The Trussell Trust Chipping Barnet Foodbank**

*Since starting the foodbank donations in late September 2020, the parish of St Mary Magdalen's have donated 1320.3kg of food to the Trussell Trust's Chipping Barnet Foodbank. This is equivalent to 150 pre-packed food parcels which would feed about 120 people. Our foodbank provide individuals and families who are referred to us in crisis with at least three days' worth of emergency food and support. We ensure that the food parcels contain healthy and balanced meals.*

*Every day people in the UK go hungry for reasons ranging from redundancy to receiving an unexpected bill on a low income. A simple box of food makes a big difference, with foodbanks helping prevent crime, housing loss, family breakdown and mental health problems.*

*As a parish, you have made a big difference. Many thanks to you for organising this, to Fr Liddle for enabling it and your parishioners for their generosity.*
