

**THEFT.** Sadly, the Card Reader was stolen from the Church last Saturday. No personal details are stored on the Reader so nothing can be obtained by the thief or recipient. We are currently waiting to see if our Insurance covers replacement. If not, the unit will cost almost £500 to replace, so we are awaiting details of this, and the possibility of a securer replacement product. It is unlikely that there will be a replacement before Christmas.

**HEATING.** We are so very grateful for the generosity of the donation of new boilers for the church; please pray for the intentions of the Donor. The Parish Finance Committee has arranged for the system to feed into the Shrine Chapel and Sacristy, which at the moment are heated separately. Work is likely to take place early this week on days when the church may be closed for the works on the organ, but please understand that there may be some noise as these essential works are carried out.
