Today we conclude the Sundays of the Christian Year with the Feast of Christ the King. Christ the King is one of the names of Jesus found in various forms in Scripture. He is referred to as King Eternal, King of Israel, King of the Jews, King of kings and King of the Ages.

The Feast of Christ the King was instituted by Pope Pius XI in his encyclical Quas Primas in 1925. As a response to the rise of secularism and unrest between nations, Pope Pius stated, "Men must look for the peace of Christ in the Kingdom of Christ.".

The Feast of Christ the King, also called 'Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe,' is a festival celebrated in the Catholic Church in honour of Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation. Essentially, it is a magnification of the Feast of the Ascension.

> Almighty and eternal God, you have made of one blood all the nations of the earth and will that they live together in peace and harmony;

so order the course of this world that all peoples may be brought together under Christ's most gentle rule; We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, you Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit who is alive with you and the Holy Spirit, one God now and for ever. Amen.
