Lord Jesus, keep me always alert and awake to you, to your word, your action, and your daily presence in my life. Let me see your glory. A message Fr Stephen: Dear brothers and sisters,

By now many of you will be aware that during last Sunday night the church was burgled. Looking around at the moment, you might be hard pressed to see any evidence, but sadly, it happened. After some diversionary tactics as the church was closed after the evening mass the Burglar hid themselves in church, and later began their assault on our property, which was only discovered on opening the church on Monday morning. They tried to break into money boxes, they successfully broke into the Repository and stole about £110 in charity (not church) money, they forced the doors by the pulpit, and then broke into the Hall where they stole audio-visual equipment, but failed to gain access to the kitchen, though causing damage to locks, bolts and doors. The worst attack was on the Sacristy where they took some time to break in; the lock buckled but held, and in the end they smashed their way through double panels in the door to gain access, and then rifled through all the drawers and cupboards. At present we do not think that they took anything more other than a row of church chairs from the Holy Souls Chapel! Of course, as things are cleared up we may find some other items missing, but it seems that their haul was not of much value in material terms to them. Much more expensive in terms of material value and time putting right is the damage caused which will run into thousands of pounds. After dealing with Police, Scene of Crime Officers, the Diocesan authorities, Insurance Company and the locksmith to make things secure, we now look forward to a Diocesan Surveyor visiting on Tuesday and Loss Adjuster on Thursday before we know the next actions to restore both that which has been damaged, and that which has been stolen. We will also be considering extra security measures to protect the church building, property, and community.

Many thanks for the kind expressions of concern and solidarity... and keep vigilant! Fr Stephen.
