ST MARY MAGDALEN CATHOLIC CHURCH DECEMBER — MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT 11 DECEMBER YEAR A

A friend of mine 'phoned me last week with the news that the recent Census has revealed the statistic that 46.2% of people in the United Kingdom define themselves as Christian. 'As many as that!' I replied, only half in jest. Religion, and I think especially Christianity, comes under attack from so many sources these days that I am surprised that any person under the age of 30 has any faith at all. There are people like Richard Dawkins who seek to deny the existence of God. There are fiction writers who seek to demonise the Church. When did you last see a normal Catholic family as part of a drama on television? People with faith are often portrayed as slightly mad, or as criminals.

The statistics from the Census are interesting. It is among white British people that there is the most marked decline in Christianity. Among Black British people 72% are Christian and the non-British White community is 60% Christian*. This is certainly reflected in the life of the Catholic Church in London. Just look around you at Mass and see the wonderful diversity of our congregations, the faith which is here, and the young people who are still coming to Mass. I think the media would be astonished to see the numbers at Mass in our parishes, and also the diversity of age and background. That will never get reported of course. I don't think we will ever see a Catholic family on EastEnders.

These statistics mean we have work to do. Our sacramental programmes, getting under way in January, should strengthen the faith of our children and young people. But adults also need to be formed in their faith, and I am currently looking into programmes which will help us all deepen our faith in Jesus Christ and in His Church.

May God keep us all strong in our faith!
