BE GENEROUS!

I think St Peter probably thought he was erring on the side of generosity when he suggested to Jesus that he should forgive his brother seven times. He may have been thinking that once was enough! Jesus responds by telling him that he must forgive seventy seven times – in other words, he must be generous beyond reason with his mercy and forgiveness. Jesus then goes on to tell a parable about a man who is let off a debt of £3,000,000 in today's money. Again, generous beyond reason with his mercy and forgiveness. We must ask for the grace to imitate this forgiveness and mercy. Pope Francis, in very moving words in his book The Name of God is Mercy, reminds us all, but especially priests who hear confessions, that we must be merciful:

'To follow the way of the Lord, the Church is called on to dispense mercy over all those who recognise themselves as sinners, who assume responsibility for the evil they have committed , and who feel in the need of forgiveness. The Church does exist to condemn people but to bring about an encounter with the visceral love of God's mercy. I often say that in order for this to happen, it is necessary to go out: to go out from the churches and the parishes, to go outside and look for people where they live, where they suffer and where they hope. I like to use the image of a field hospital to describe this 'Church that goes forth'...it offers first aid and immediate care, so that its soldiers do not die'. (The Name of God is Mercy, p50)

My prayer is that we will all find forgiveness when we come to the priest in the confessional and are truly sorry for our sins. My prayer is that priests will truly be ministers of God's forgiving love. My prayer is that we will all be generous beyond reason with mercy and forgiveness.
